### **POSTERS' PRESENTATION TYPE AND TEMPLATE**

There are three categories for posters, and the presentation of all posters will be done exclusively as e-posters (printed posters will not be accepted) in accordance to the provided FN template attached (will be added to FNAM2020 webpages until 17th February). The posters made in FN template will be needed to be added to the FNAM2020 webpage until 6th April.

### **POSTERS' CATEGORIES AND GUIDELINES:**

#### **1. SCIENTIFIC POSTERS:**

Presentation of research projects (Education, Internalization, Midwifery and Nursing). Lecturers and students can be authors of these posters. For a scientific poster presentation, you are required to submit an abstract in accordance to the guidelines.

**The scientific posters will undergo a peer-review process by the Academic Committee panel. Please submit your scientific poster abstract to the Academic Committee until 13th March 2020 to the email: [smantzoukas@ioa.teiep.gr](mailto:smantzoukas@ioa.teiep.gr)**

**Guidelines for Abstracts of Scientific Posters (150-250 words)**

- Category: Scientific
- Name, Title
- Background/ Research question, method, results/findings, discussion/conclusion
- Contact information: name, title, institution, address, email

**After the acceptance of the scientific poster abstract, the authors need to add the poster made in FN template to this FNAM2020 webpages until 6th April, 2020.**

### 2. INSTITUTIONAL POSTERS:

Presentation of your own organization/institution, projects, didactic methods, educational / clinical procedures etc. Lecturers and students can be authors of these posters. For the e-poster presentation, you are required to submit your poster accordance to the guidelines. Institutional posters do not undergo peer-review process.

#### Guidelines for the presentation of institutional poster

- Deliver your institutional poster to this FNAM2020 webpage to Category: Institutional until 6th April, 2020 made in FN template
- Content of poster in FN Template
  - o Name, Title
  - o Institution, project or/and didactic method information, implication and evaluation/ discussion/conclusion (100-150 words)
  - o Contact information: name, title, institution, email
  - o Institutional / Project Logo can be added to FN Template (optional)

### 3. STUDENTS' POSTERS:

Experiences, research activities, thesis, projects, educational or clinical cases /procedures etc. Only students can be authors of these posters. Student posters do not undergo a peer-review process.

#### Guidelines for the presentation of students' posters

- Deliver your student poster to this FNAM2020 webpage to Category: Student until 6th April 2020 made in FN template
- Content of poster in FN Template
  - o Name, Title
  - o Thesis, projects or/and clinical cases information, background/ study question / method / findings / discussion /conclusion 100-150 words)
  - o Contact information: name, title, institution, email
  - o Institutional / Project Logo can be added to FNA Template (optional)

## e-POSTERS PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

The information of the places for e-poster presentations will be given to authors later. There will be big screens in particular places at the campus of Savonia University of Applied Sciences, where authors of e-posters will have the opportunity to present their posters, and the attendees will have time to discuss and ask questions about it. Therefore, at least one of the authors of the e-poster is required to attend the FNAM2020 meeting and conference.

Electric presentations of the posters will be available at the FNAM2020 webpage.

### **POSTERS' AWARDS:**

There will be a prize for the best e-poster in each poster category. Every e-poster accepted and presented is open to an award in its relevant category.

The participants of the FNAM2020 and other attendees will have the opportunity to vote their favorite e-poster of each category during the meeting /conference before General Assembly on Thursday 14th May 2020 at 15.30.

The posters' awards will be announced in the Closing Ceremony on Thursday 14th May, 2020.

### **POSTERS' CERTIFICATES:**

Every author of the scientific poster will receive a certificate of authorship signed by the FN Academic Committee Group. The authors of posters in institutional and students' categories will have the certificates signed by Savonia University of Applied Sciences as the Host University of the FNAM2020 and stamped.
